

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between the Adichunchanagiri University, BG Nagara, Nagamangala Taluk, Mandya District, Karnataka State, herein after called "ACU" and the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University Karapakkam, Chennai, Tamil Nadu herein after called "TNTEU". ACU and TNTEU are referred to collectively as 'parties' or individually as 'party'.

This Memorandum of Understanding has been executed at BG Nagara on 24.06.2021 through the Chief functionaries of the parties

- I. Whereas Adichunchanagiri University is a multi-disciplinary University established in the year 2018 at BG Nagara, Bangalore- Mangalore National Highway No.75, Karnataka State, India. Adichunchanagiri University has been declared as a State Private University under the ACU Act, 2012 (Karnataka Act No. 18 of 2013). It is offering Under Graduate, Post Graduate degrees and Doctoral programs in Education, Medicine, Pharmacy, Nursing, Engineering, Commerce and Natural Sciences. With the vision of "To create better Teachers of tomorrow" University is offering B.Ed and Ph.D in Education (www.acu.edu.in).
- II. And whereas the TNTEU is an exclusive University for Teacher Education established in the year 2008 by the Government of Tamil Nadu (Act No.33 of 2008) to promote excellence in Teacher Education. This University is unique in nature relatively to the other Universities since its assignment is to promote excellence in teacher education and produce dynamic and smart teachers for the benefit of the society and the nation at large, with six Departments of Study viz. Department of Pedagogical Sciences, Department of Value Education, Department of Educational Psychology, Department of Educational Technology, Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation, and Department of Educational Planning and Administration. TNTEU produces M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. scholars every year through the University Departments as well as through 680 affiliated Colleges of Education in Tamil Nadu (www.tnteu.ac.in).

III. Purpose and Objectives:

1. The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards cultural exchange and providing education and life skills to students. Hence, the parties desire to work together with the following objectives in accordance with the Adichunchanagiri University Act 7(6) and (7).
 - 1.1 To organize training, conferences, seminars and workshops for enhancing the Education and Teaching skills and character development.
 - 1.2 To conduct on-line training programmes.
 - 1.3 To share and exchange ideas and expertise in curriculum designing and transaction.
 - 1.4 To share and exchange both faculty and students for a common concern for the development of higher education and pursuit of academic excellence in higher education.
 - 1.5 To conduct certificate and diploma courses.
 - 1.6 To do research and field analysis.
 - 1.7 To encourage the Faculty Members to participate and contribute as resource persons in students' programmes.
 - 1.8 To strengthen the educational relationships between the ACU and TNTEU for the welfare of the society.

2 Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:


- 2.1 That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest with the Registrar of Adichunchanagiri University and Registrar of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University. There shall not be absolutely any financial commitment on the part of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and Adichunchanagiri University under any circumstances.
- 2.2 That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the parties.

3 General:

The broad general areas of cooperation envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding will include:

- 3.1 Participation of Faculty members and the students of both Undergraduate and Post-graduate programmes of study conducted in TNTEU and Field exposure conducted by Adichunchanagiri University as would be appropriate, with no financial commitments on the part of the University.
- 3.2 The focus on off-site short training programmes and field-based studies organized by Adichunchanagiri University, on behalf of TNTEU would be appropriate.
- 3.3 Exchange of staff and students including research scholars on collaborative teaching, research and other academic assignments in accordance with their respective mission.
- 3.4 Mutual participation in academic/social community activities like seminars, conferences, workshops, library exchanges, language programmes and so on in curriculum planning and evaluation, educational psychology value education, pedagogical sciences, educational technology and educational planning and administration.
- 3.5 Guidance, advice and training of Staff Development and Career Guidance of Students and other stakeholders.
- 3.6 The authorities of both parties will support the activities to be carried out under this Memorandum of Understanding by providing necessary facilities.
- 3.7 The Memorandum of Understanding will come into operation on the date of signing of this Memorandum and operate for five years in the first instance subject to a mid-term review after three years and an end-of-term review after five years. It may be extended or terminated by mutual consent.
- 3.8 The TNTEU and ACU agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each may unilaterally withdraw after three months' notice to the other party.
- 3.9 The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the programmes.
- 3.10 The TNTEU shall not have any sort of financial commitment during sharing of any infrastructural facilities in respect of any of the activities envisaged in the MoU.

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed subject to the approval of the Syndicate of TNTEU and ACU.

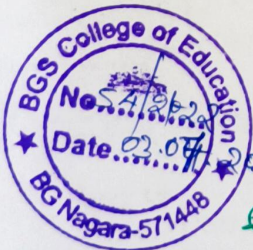

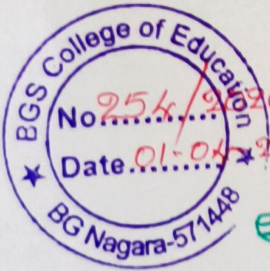
