PREAMBLE

Institute is approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi. The Institute has shown its presence at the national level by being ranked in the band width 76-100 in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) by the Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD), Government of India in the year 2019 & 2020.

The Institute gives number of opportunities to its students and strives to equip them by providing the skills, ability, and knowledge required for life - long learning and success. The Institute is reputed for the outstanding students graduating from its undergraduate and postgraduate programmes. WHEREAS

ISF College of Pharmacy (An Autonomous College), Moga, established in 1984 is recognized by AICTE & PCI, New Delhi and having its registered office at GT Road, Ghal-Kalan, Moga (hereinafter called "ISFCP" which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its administrators, executors, successors and assignees). ISFCP is accredited by NAAC Grade "A", in NIRF-2020 achieved 52nd rank in Pharmacy category by MHRD and Govt. of India. The Institute is also recognized among top "3 Best Pharmacy Institute" in India by AICTE-CIL New Delhi and Best Pharmacy Institute in Punjab by CMAI in collaboration with IKGPTU and AICTE. ISFCP has 39 well-equipped Research Labs for UG, PG and PhD Program and 12 specialized labs i.e. Nano-Technology, Microbial Cell Culture, Cell Culture, Polymer Lab, NDDS, Tissue Culture, CADD, Cardiovascular, Zebra Fish, Industrial Pharmaceutical Lab, Food Lab, Herbal Technology etc. Institute is also running Analytical Lab (ISFAL) approved by NABL, CDSCO and Govt. of Punjab. Running CPCSEA approved animal house with breeding and trading facility. ISFCP aims to strengthen academia and research through education, training, research, and advocacy/policy initiatives.

The respective Institutes jointly recognize this MoU to mutually cooperate in the areas of Pharmacy and Life Science Education, Research and Development as well as support to research and development.

OBJECTIVES

The primary purpose of this MoU is to build academic research capacity, to promote mutual understanding between the Research establishments at the Institutes as well as for technical support to research. The MoU shall formally set out the terms of cooperative relationship between

the parties, establish their respective roles, and facilitate the function of each party in relation to collaborative research.

The parties agree to develop collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interests, entrepreneurship development and as equal partners with reciprocity.

The development and implementation of specific activities based on MoU shall be negotiated and agreed between individual faculty members and/or through the Heads of the Department/Institute. This MoU is agreed on the basis of cooperation between the parties and includes, but is not limited to, the following aspects:

- a. To conduct collaborative research projects and jointly apply for research funds
- b. Conducting colloquiums
- c. Exchange of academic/research information and related materials to facilitate joint publications by collaborating faculty members
- d. Promoting any academic activities of interest based on mutual agreement
- e. Utilization of Library, Laboratory facilities and software, as per agreed terms
- f. Mentoring or Technical support to the incubatees, as needed
- g. Exchange of faculty members/ research scholars /students based on the projects and research needs
- h. Utilization of Animal house and ISF Analytical Lab (Approved by NABL) after mutual discussion related to cost of proposal.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. The parties will manage their own financial liabilities, aroused out of collaborative academic and research projects.
2. Intellectual Property Rights: IPR titles or ownership of any product, proprietary information or technology tools, processes, utilities, and methodology for any deliverables, new ideas, inventions, or development conceived, developed or made jointly by ACU - SACCP and ISFCP under the ambit of this MoU shall remain the property of all the parties, as agreed mutually. This clause shall remain valid even after the termination or expiry of this MoU.
3. In no event shall any party be liable for any indirect, incidental, special consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of profits, revenue, data or use, incurred by the other party in connection with arising out of or under this agreement, save for any such loss suffered resulting from any willful and negligent act or omission of either of the parties.
4. During the tenure of the MOU, the parties agree to respect confidentiality of any work or material provided in confidence. The parties would seek each other's permission before assigning any Intellectual Property Rights to a third party.
5. Neither this agreement, nor any activity described herein shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, agency or other such relationship between the parties and nothing

contained herein shall preclude either party from participating/initiating similar relationship with third parties.

6. This MoU may not be amended without the prior written consent of each of the parties.
7. This MoU will come into force and deemed to have commenced from the date of its signing and shall continue for a period of five (5) years from thereof and be automatically renewed for successive period of five years, unless either of the parties notifies in writing to the other party of its intentions to terminate this MoU, ninety days in advance.
8. This MoU is not a legally binding contract and under no circumstances does this MoU subject either parties to liability for breach of contract or any other liability under national or international law or any other applicable law.
9. The parties herchy agree that they are not bound exclusively by this MoU and shall be at a liberty to enter into any separate agreements or arrangements with any third party without reference to the other party.
10. If during the tenure of the MOU any joint program is delayed due to reason of Force Majeure nature such as acts of God, acts of public enemy, acts of government, fire, flood, strike, epidemic and civil commotion, the extension of the joint programs would be mutually decided.
11. Each of ACU - SACCP and ISFCP warrant that this MoU is not likely to have any conflict of interest with any of their organizational, financial, contractual or other interests relating to the work under this MoU.
12. TERMINATION: If either party fails to fulfill its respective obligations as set out in the previous clauses of this MoU, the parties shall consult each other with a view to correcting the default by the party concerned. If even thereafter the default is not rectified by the defaulting party, then the other party may terminate this MoU by giving ninety (90) days' notice in writing to the defaulting party provided that such termination shall not affect the rights of the parties to the MoU which have accrued prior to such termination.

The Institutes agree to carry out the above-mentioned activities in accordance with laws and regulations of respective institution after full consultation and approvals.
