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

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between District Health and F.W. Society (Blindness Control Division) and participating Non Government Organization

1. PREAMBLE:

WHEREAS the Union Cabinet has approved continuation of National Program for Control of Blindness, hereafter referred to as NPCBVI, for implementation in all the States of the country during the period 2023-2024;

- WHEREAS NPCBVI nims to reduce prevalence of blindness by implementing various activities through State and District Health& F.W. Societies (BCD) established in all
- 1.3 WHEREAS the NPCBVI seeks to involve eye care facilities in Government, Non National Program for Control of Blindness;
- AND WHEREAS schemes for Non Government Organizations (hereafter referred as NGO/Private Practitioner) providing eye care services are implemented as per pattern of assistance approved by the Cabinet;
- 1.5 NOW THEREFORE the signatories of Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) have agreed as set out here in below.

2. PARTIESOF MOU:

This MOU is an agreement between District Health &F.W. Society (Blindness Control Division) of RAMANAGARA DISTRICT, of the State of KARNATAKA; hereafter called District Health Society and ADICHUNCHANAGIRI HOSPHTAL AND RESEARCH CENTER, BG Nagara Nagamangala Tq of Mandya D

3. DURATION OF MOU:

This MOU will be operative from the date of its signing by the parties and remain in force from 16th Aug2023 to 31th March 2024 for a period of one year. The MOU shall be renewed for further period, through mutual agreement by the parties.

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6. Grant in Aid to NGO is governed as follows:

Reimbursement for Cataract operation for NGO and Private Practitioners as per NGO norms

@Rs.2000/-.

Grant-in-aid for treatment /management of other eye diseases to NGO and private practitioners as Diabetic Retinopathy @ Rs.2000/-, Childhood blindness @ Rs.2000/-, Glaucoma @ Rs.2000/-, Keratoplasty @ Rs.7500/-, and Vitroretinal Surgery @ Rs.10000/-, Payment will be made to NGO per operated case if the NGO has used all facilities of own like Drugs & Consumables, Sutures, Spectacles, Transports/POL, organization including their own Eye Hospital and Ophthalmologist.

7. Termination of MOU:

Commitments agreed to by the Parties are meant for prevention and control of blindness and therefore MOU should generally not be suspended or terminated. However, both parties can decide to suspend or terminate the MOU.

Additional Criteria for MOU 2023-24

Any complication arising as a result of our DBCS Camp for the public and patients, during examination, Laboratory procedures, Transportation and during the patients stay in our hospital. Is taken as responsibility for our institutions the entre management and follow up of the complication.

Any Complications arise during Minor/Major surgical procedure, Therapeutic procedure will be completely taken as responsibility of our Hospital/Institution.

Management of such Complications will be under our responsibility and supervisions free of cost with no burden to the patients or DBCS Ramanagara.

Any Complications or Claims made by the patients or their attender's for the same complications will be completely bourn and paid by our Hospital/ Institution. The DBCS Ramanagara will not be made party for any claims.
