1. SRI ADICHUNCHANAGIRI MAHASAMSTHANA MATH



Adichunchanagiri Mahasamsthana Math is situated on a rocky hill at Sri Adichunchanagiri Kshetra, Nagamangala Taluk, Mandya District, Karnataka State, 110 Kms west of Bengaluru at an altitude of above 3,300 ft. The lush green woods and serenity of the lakes provide a sanctified atmosphere for spiritual aspirants to meditate and the Seers to internalize themselves. Amidst this serenity stands the Adichunchanagiri Mahasamsthana Math (<https://maps.app.goo.gl/1c4PFLMvhsc5zQH68>) with Lord Gangadhareshwara as the presiding deity along with four incarnations of Lord Shiva viz., Lord Malleshwara, Lord Kattale Someshwara, Lord Gavi Siddeshwara, and Lord Chandramouleshwara in their ferocious forms for demolishing the Demons and the unrighteous. People of all sections of society worship Lord Kalabhyraveswara across the country.

2. SRI ADICHUNCHANAGIRI SHIKSHANA TRUST ®

Sri Sri Sri Dr. Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji established Sri Adichunchanagiri Shikshana Trust (R) in 1973 with the prime aim of enlightening the rural youth and facilitating education not only accessible, but also affordable. Presently, the Trust is running 518 Educational Institutions across India and abroad offering quality education to about 1.5 lakh students with a scientific outlook, cultural background and spiritual touch.

3. ADICHUNCHANAGIRI UNIVERSITY



Adichunchanagiri University (<https://maps.app.goo.gl/H2NBiDqgJESX9nn18>), established in 2018, is situated in a lush green unitary campus of 67 acres at BG Nagara, Nagamangala Tq, Mandya District, Karnataka on the Bengaluru – Mangaluru National Highway No. 75, about 105 Kms from Bengaluru, the capital city of Karnataka and 16 acres at BGS Vijnatham South Campus at Nagarur, Bengaluru. The University consists of constituent colleges in the disciplines of Engineering, Management, Medicine, Pharmacy, Nursing, Commerce, Education, Allied Health Sciences, Natural Sciences, along with the School of Faculty Empowerment and Professional Development. Potential Centers of Excellence established are ACU-Centre for Research and Innovation, Adichunchanagiri Institute for Molecular Medicine, Center of Research Management and Industrial Linkage, Center for Molecular Pharmaceutics and Advanced Therapeutics.

The environment-friendly campus has adequate infrastructure and physical facilities for academics and research. The University is having total student strength of 7104 students, 930 teaching faculty, 48 Adjunct /Visiting faculty and 1500 non-teaching staff, which includes hospital-supporting staff.

4. OBJECTS OF THE UNIVERSITY

 - b) Health Sciences including Medical, Dental, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Naturopathy, Pharma, Nursing and any other emerging areas including interdisciplinary etc.
 - c) Agricultural Sciences and Technology School or College or Center.
 - d) Management and Technology including Business Management, Tourism Management, Hotel Management, Hospitality Management, Hospital Management, Disaster Management, Risk Management and any other emerging areas of study including inter- disciplinary areas etc.
 - e) Natural Sciences including Physics, Electronics, Mathematics, ·Computer Science, Chemical and Environmental Sciences, Biological Sciences, Earth Sciences, Space Sciences, Nano Science and Nano-Materials and any other emerging area of study including, interdisciplinary etc.
 - f) Humanities and Social Sciences including History, Kannada, Economics, Political Science, Journalism, Tourism, Law, ·Philosophy, Puranas and Pravachanas, Music; Art, Fashion Design including 3-D Design, Animation, Culture, Social Works, Sanskrit, English, other Indian and Foreign Languages and. any other emerging areas of study including interdisciplinary areas etc.
 - g) Any other emerging areas, faculty, or field of study across the globe.
- ii To design and deliver high quality training, capacity building and development

systems for teachers, teacher educators, teachers in higher and professional education, Leadership training including political leaders, administrators and development professionals working in education and other systems.

- iii To institute degrees, diplomas including PG Diplomas, dual degree programmes, integrated courses, certificates and other academic distinctions like awards, award of credits on the basis of:
 - a) Successful completion of academic work evaluated through multiple methods including modern methods of assessment; and
 - b) Outstanding contributions like writing original book or books, research publication,
 - c) Services in the areas of cultural and spiritual by eminent persons in different areas of learning.
- iv To collaborate with any other universities, research institutions, non-profit organization, industry associations, professional associations or other organizations to conceptualize, design, develop and offer specific educational and research programmes, training programmes and exchange programmes for students, faculty members and others;
- v To disseminate knowledge and develop a public debate on issues of education and allied development fields through a series of lectures, seminars, conferences, executive education programmes, community development programmes, publications, training programmes and events.
- vi To Initiate and undertake programs for the development and training of faculty, researchers, and support staff of the University in partnership, collaboration, co-operation, Joint venture, strategic or any other form of a mutually beneficial relationship with any other institution or institutions of similar vision, mission, strategic architecture and objectives.
 - a) To undertake collaborative research and advocacy with any organizations.
 - b) To undertake necessary or expedient action to pursue and promote the objectives of the University.
 - c) To undertake any objectives as may be approved by the Government for the enhancement of the education and other development sectors.

10.4 Community Health Care Services

By virtue of the institution being located in a rural place and run by the Sri

Adichunchanagiri Math, one of its objectives is to provide access to quality health care at an affordable cost to the rural mass. AHRC caters to the healthcare needs of rural masses from a wide geographical area including 5 districts namely Mandya, Hassan, Tumakuru, Ramanagara and Bengaluru Rural.

As a part of the institution's social responsibility, AHRC has conducted a total of 351 health camps, 25 General health check-up camps & 7 Blood Donation camps, 278 Eye Camps in association with Jilla andatva nivarana samste. Hassan, Mandya, Tumakuru, Diabetic retinopathy camp 1, ENT camp 2, Surgery & Pediatric Surgery camp 2, Skin/Dermatology camp 5, Diabetic Neuropathy camp 1, Mental Health Outreach Programme 1, OBG camp 5, Pediatric Camp 5, Free cardiology camp (Angiogram & Angioplasty) 1, Free cervical & Breast cancer survey & Awareness camp 1, Students Health checkup camp 5 and 5 other camps in the academic year 2024-25. Over 23629 people were screened in these camps and 4240 patients were treated free of cost at AHRC. In addition to these 278 free eye camps were also conducted as a part of the National program for the prevention of blindness, which benefited around 8301 patients with free cataract surgery and spectacles. An amount Rs.13,21,602/- was spent for these camps during the year 2024-25

11.2 Major Initiatives undertaken during 2024-25

- The university has renewed its subscription to e-resources such as **ProQuest Health Research Premium Collection (Aggregator)**, **CliniLearn** digital platform, and **IEEE: ASPP + CSDL** Online database. A remote access facility has been provided for users to access the subscribed e-resources.
- **DELNET** membership has been renewed to ensure continued access to the resources for the users.

- The university is currently subscribed to IBM SPSS software v30.0, and installed at all ACU institutions for researchers.
- The university had subscribed to Wolters Kluwer's Lippincott Medical Education (31 Nursing eBooks) for the benefit of nursing faculty and students.
- The university had subscribed to the Turnitin plagiarism software this year and offered services to the research community. All the Constituent Colleges and Research Centres have used the services.
- Under the ambit of Adichunchanagiri University, the off-campus **BGMCH library** started functioning at Nagaruru, Bengaluru North Taluk. The library is established as per the norms of the National Medical Council, New Delhi. The library had procured some books and subscribed to 74 new journals for the learning community.
- The ACU Learning Resource Centre has procured the books and journals for the new programmes offered by the institution. The new programmes are MD in Emergency Medicine and M.Ch. programmes in Neurosurgery, Plastic Surgery, and Urology during the year.
- The ACU Learning Resource Centre also particularly procured the books for the programmes offered to Clinical Psychology and physiotherapy during the year.
- The core books were used regularly at Adichunchanagiri College of Nursing library. Due to the continuous usage, they were getting damaged, and they got rebounded for usage.
- Revival of Library Automation Technology through cloud computing for Koha software - Proposal submitted and approved by the Purchase Committee to M/S Appspot Software India Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore. It helps all the libraries to work under a single interface. With this initiation, the library operations went on smoothly.
- For the ACU Learning Resource Centre, 50 new computers have been purchased for the Digital Library.
- The half-yearly LIS PhD progress review meeting was held on 3rd September 2024; All researchers attended and presented their reports.
- The half-yearly LIS Ph.D. review meeting was held on 15th January 2025; All the researchers attended and presented their reports.
- The researchers of Library and Information Science have attended 5 conferences, presented their 14 papers, and published in the proceedings. The conferences were held as follows:
 - Asian Conference on Intelligent Technologies (ACOIT) September 2024, Kolar.
 - 5th LIS Academy Conference 17th to 19 October LISACON-2024, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli.
 - International Conference on Digital Landscape in Library (DLL 4.0), 2nd – 4th December 2025, Bangalore University, Bangalore.
 - National Conference on “Envisioning the Future: AI Tools for Libraries”, February 2025, Goa.
 - National Conference on Modern Library Technologies and Services (NCMLTS-2025), 28-29 March 2025, MAHE, Bangalore.
- The researchers of Library and Information Science have attended 1 seminar, presented their 4 papers, and published in the proceedings. The seminar was held as follows:
 - National seminar on "Vision Viksit Bharat @ 2047", January 2025, Bidar.

- In addition to the conferences and seminar papers published, 3 research articles were also published in journals during the period.
- The Doctoral Advisory Committee meeting was held on 27th February 2025 for the two newly admitted Ph.D. scholars in Library and Information Science during the year 2024-25. The researchers have presented their synopsis in the DAC and submitted their final Ph.D. synopsis by incorporating all suggestions made in the DAC.
- The university has signed the revised MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, to deposit the thesis for the Shodhganga repository produced by the university.
- Correction of ACU institution(s) research data in the Web of Sciences database (Clarivate): (name variants, merging, preferred name) was completed. The preferred names of the ACU institutions were set and reflected properly in the database.
- Mapping the research data being used in quality initiatives, ranking frameworks, accreditation, and other processes of an institution/university was attended.
- The library has initiated the Research Management System at the university (<https://acu.irins.org>) to showcase the research productivity of ACU. New faculty profiles have been created. The faculty research data are being updated on the portal.
- All the Librarians have participated in NAAC review meetings organised by the institution/university from time to time. The librarians have submitted the learning resources data to the Dean, Academic and Accreditation for preparing the SSR for the NAAC I cycle.
- SWAYAM-NPTEL Local Chapter has been started under the name of Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences. Few students have enrolled for the NPTEL & Swayam courses of January 2025 by selecting AIMS Chapter – 6126.
- The Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences has instituted a “**Best Library User Award**” for the two outgoing MBBS students of the year. Dr. Prajwal, A G, and Dr. Kavana, C R have won the “Best Library User Award” for the year 2024-25. The award was issued to them during the Graduation Day celebration.
- The Chief Librarian participated in the One-day Clarivate Awareness and Engagement Programme 2024, held in Bengaluru on 6th August 2024.
- Librarians have been represented on several Academic, Administrative, and Research committees. They participate in University Council/College Councils, Academic and Research Councils. Librarians are working on institutional quality initiatives such as IQAC, NBA, nirf, and the ISO Certification programmes.
- ACU Librarians have conducted annual events in the Learning Centers. During the occasion, a few Webinars, Workshops, and Guest Lectures were organized for the faculty and students.

12.3 Residential Accommodation for Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff:

Hostels for students and residential houses are built for providing lodging accommodation for teachers and other employees of Adichunchanagiri University. University provides residential university campus where teachers, students and other employees share composite life as an academic community and an academic township. Presently 244 quarters are available for teaching and Non-teaching staff. 7 storied apartments to accommodate 90 nurses in AIMS campus and 7 storied Boys Hostel consisting of 168 rooms to accommodate 500 boys' students are completed now.

12.4 Guest House Complex

The Guest House of Adichunchanagiri University "VIJNATHAM BHAVAN" has 38 rooms with all amenities, one central dining hall with lounge and one meeting hall in the first floor.

12.5 ICT Infrastructure

All the institutions of ACU provides IT services to the students Internet access through a Campus –wide Wi-Fi, LAN, University Web site, Computer and E mail service. The institutions also take care of various Video- conference and Webcast events of UGC, State and Central Governments.

12.6 Conference Halls

The constituent colleges have their own Conference halls and Committee rooms for

various Academic meetings, Seminars, Workshops, Conference, Curricular and Cultural Programs during various occasions like Independence Day, Republic Day, Pooja and Festivals etc. The University BGS auditorium with a seating capacity of 2000 is available for academic and cultural programmes.

12.7 Health Care

Health care facilities for students, faculty and non-teaching staff are provided at Adichunchanagiri Hospital and Research Centre.

12.8 Canteens

Adichunchanagiri University campus houses 3 canteens at different locations. AIMS Lounge and AHRC Canteen are located in the premises of Adichunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences and Adichunchanagiri Hospital & Research Centre, which provide breakfast, lunch and items of refreshment to the students, patient attendants, visitors, teaching and non-teaching staff of AIMS, AHRC, ACN and SACCP.

BGS Food Court located in the premises of Adichunchanagiri University caters to the food requirements of BGSIT, BGSFGC and BGSCE. The facility is also extended to the candidates appearing for various competitive exams held in the University particularly online examinations (Railway Service Selection, Banking Selection, etc). Whenever Seminars and Conferences in various departments of the University are held, their needs of refreshment, lunch and dinner are also catered as per their requirements and orders.

12.9 Bank and Post office

Bank: The University has two banks on the campus to provide banking facilities to the students, staff and their family members. The banks also provide the facility to deposit the fee through internet banking without visiting fee counter which will save the university resources.
