**Subject: Renewal of Undergraduate Seats (MBBS) of Adichunchanagiri  
Institute of Medical Sciences Bellur, for the year AY- 2025-26 – regarding.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Show Cause Notice dated 11.05.2025 was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

1. Nineteen (19) out of Twenty (20) departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.
2. As per self declaration, faculty deficiencies is observed in Anatomy, Anaesthesiology, Biochemistry, Community Medicine, Forensic Medicine, General Medicine, Microbiology, Ophthalmology, Paediatrics, Pharmacology, Physiology, Psychiatry and Radio diagnosis.
3. As per self declaration, SR deficiencies in departments of Biochemistry, Dentistry Forensic Medicine, General Medicine, Ophthalmology, Orthopaedics, ENT, Pharmacology, Physiology, Radio-diagnosis.
4. Clinical Investigation load is less in Cytopathology than expected.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:

1. Nineteen (19) out of Twenty (20) departments are still deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data, however your explanation has been accepted therefore, the college may adhere to the deficiencies found in the AEBAS.
2. SR deficiencies are still in departments.

Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

4. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report(ADR) submitted by your college/institutions and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory. To discuss the persisting deficiencies in your College, a meeting between the Dean/ Principal of your College and Expert Sub-Committee was convened at the Commission on 01.07. 2025, in the process for granting Annual Renewal of MBBS seats as per MSMER Regulation 2023 for the AY 2025-26.

5. However, UGMEB has taken a lenient view and decided to grant conditional renewal of 250 UG (MBBS) seats for the academic year 2025-26, subject to rectification of deficiencies within four months from the issuance of this letter.

6. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules of regulations.

7. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.

8. This issue with the approval of the Competent Authority.

7. In case college does not agree with the above decision of MARB, it may prefer an appeal under section 28(5) of NMC Act, 2019 addressed to Secretary NMC within 15 days of this order, through online mode only as per NMC's Public notices dated 21.05.2024 and 30.05.2024.
