



Policy on Rotary Club

1. OVERVIEW

The Policy on Rotary Club at Adichunchanagiri University (ACU) aims to establish a framework for the formation, operation, and promotion of the Rotary Club as a student and staff engagement initiative. The university seeks to foster leadership, community service, and ethical values among its members. This policy outlines the structure, objectives, and guidelines to ensure the Rotary Club aligns with the university's mission of creating opportunities for holistic development.

2. APPLICABILITY

This policy is applicable to all students, faculty, and staff members interested in joining or supporting the Rotary Club at ACU (Adichunchanagiri University).

3. OBJECTIVES

- To promote leadership skills and community service among students and staff.
- To facilitate collaboration with local and international Rotary Clubs for social initiatives.
- To encourage ethical practices and civic responsibility within the university community.

4. STRUCTURE AND MANAGEMENT

- **Formation:** The Rotary Club shall be established under the supervision of a faculty advisor appointed by the university administration, in collaboration with student representatives.

- Annual feedback from members and stakeholders shall be collected to assess the club's effectiveness and propose improvements.
