AIMS Faculty Contribute to CME On Practical Vestibular Sciences

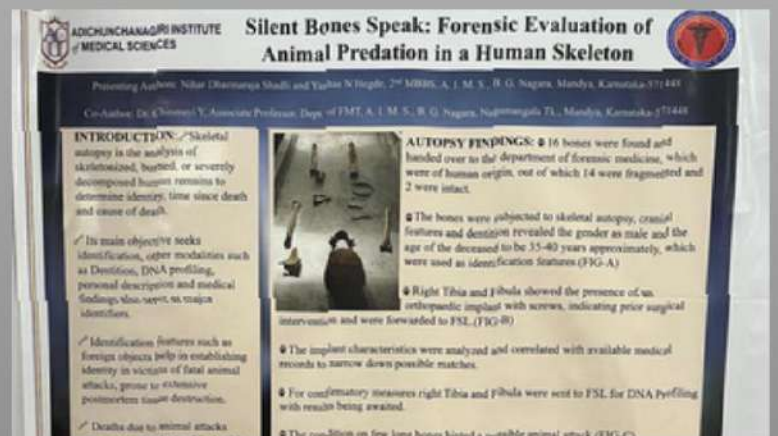

Time To Listen to The Inner ear – A practical Vestibular

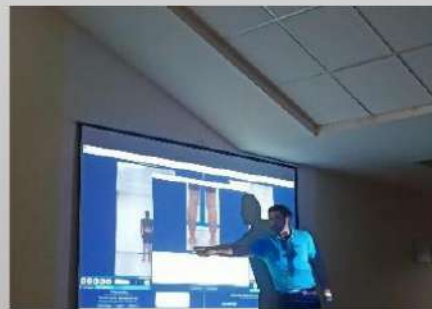

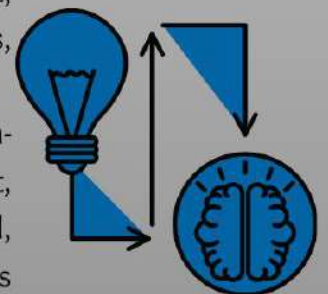
BGSVIPT WORKSHOPS

Gait Analysis Workshop

A two-day Gait Analysis Workshop was organized by BGS Vijnatham Institute of Physiotherapy on **24th & 25th March 2026** at the Biomechanics Lab, Nagarur (9 AM–4 PM). The programme aimed to understand normal and pathological gait, postural deviations, marker and camera placement, gait phases, joint kinematics, and the use of motion analysis tools in physiotherapy.

Day 1 focused on postural and gait analysis using motion sensors and camera-based recordings, with data analyzed through the GaitON App to assess alignment, symmetry, and deviations. Day 2 involved running analysis on a treadmill, evaluating stride, foot strike, and load distribution, along with comparisons between walking and running biomechanics.

Overall, the workshop enhanced clinical observation, analysis, and the integration of technology in physiotherapy practice, benefiting both students and staff.

Objectives: To strengthen marketing concepts, enhance analytical thinking, and link theory with practical application.

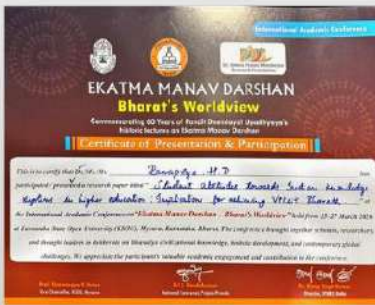

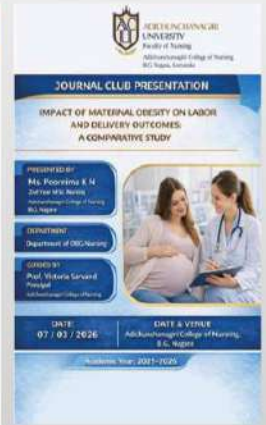
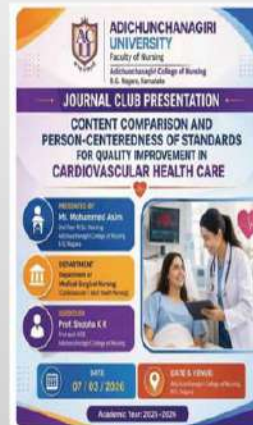
Awareness Rally

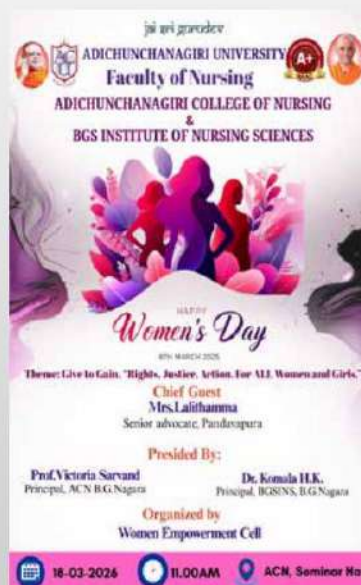

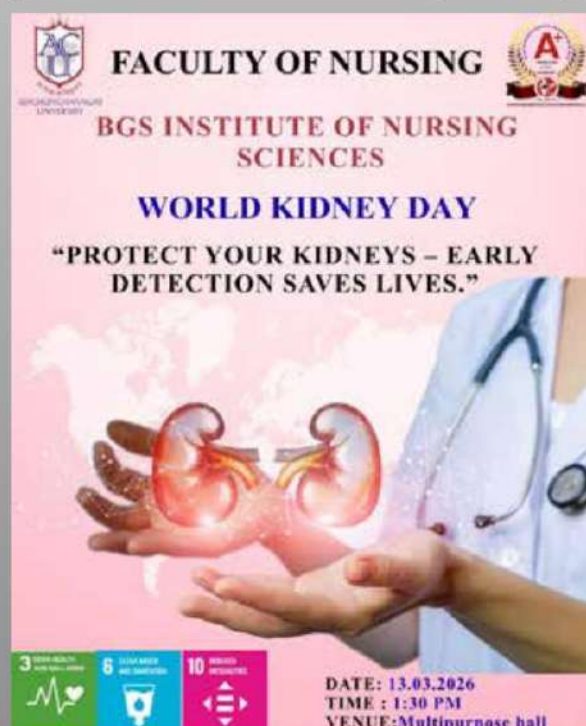

World Kidney Day

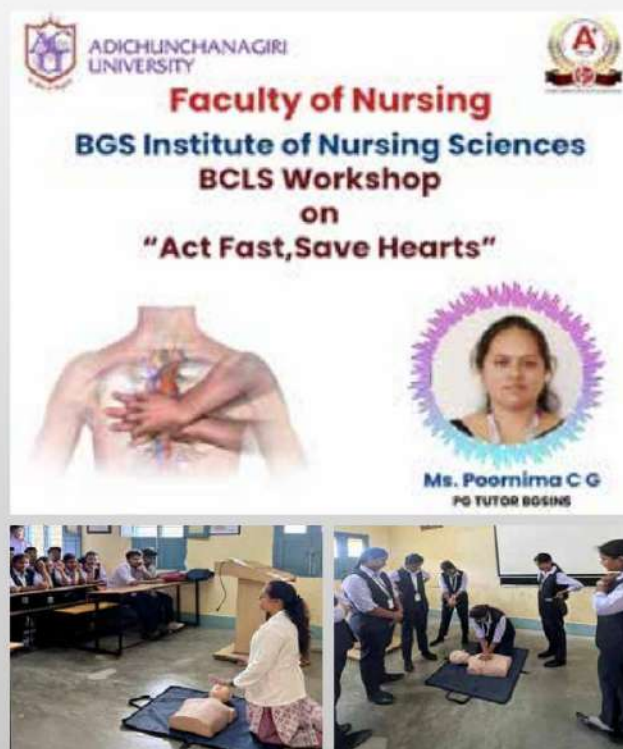

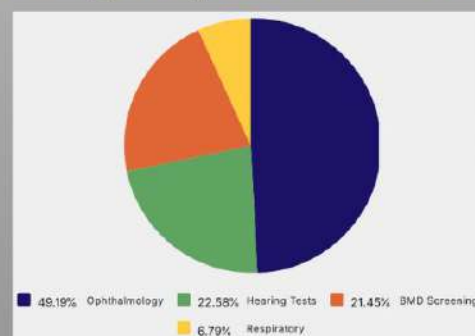

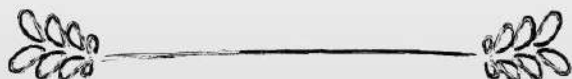
Extending Hospital Care via Outreach
