RGUHS GOLD MEDAL ACHIEVEMENT

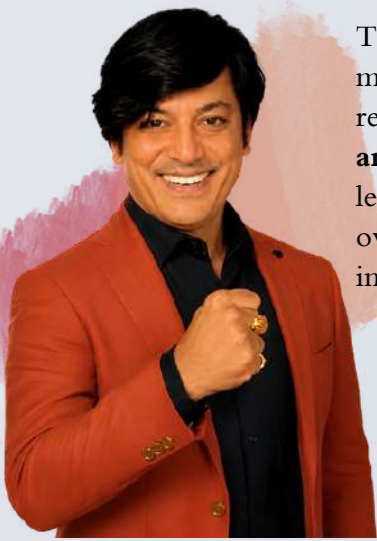
