INAUGURATION OF DIGITAL OPG UNIT AND UPGRADED DENTAL OPD

The Department of Dentistry, inaugurated a Digital Orthopantomogram X-ray Unit and an upgraded Dental Outpatient Department on 31st July 2026. The new facility includes advanced OPG imaging, two additional dental chairs, and a RadioVisuoGraphy unit, enhancing diagnostic accuracy and patient care.

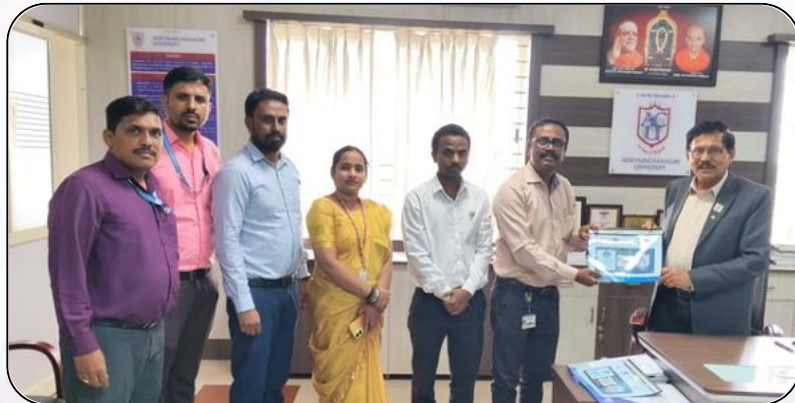


BGS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (BGSIT)

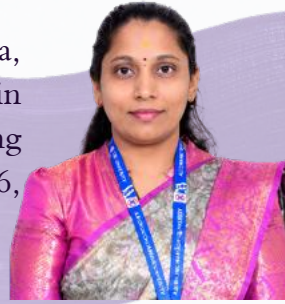

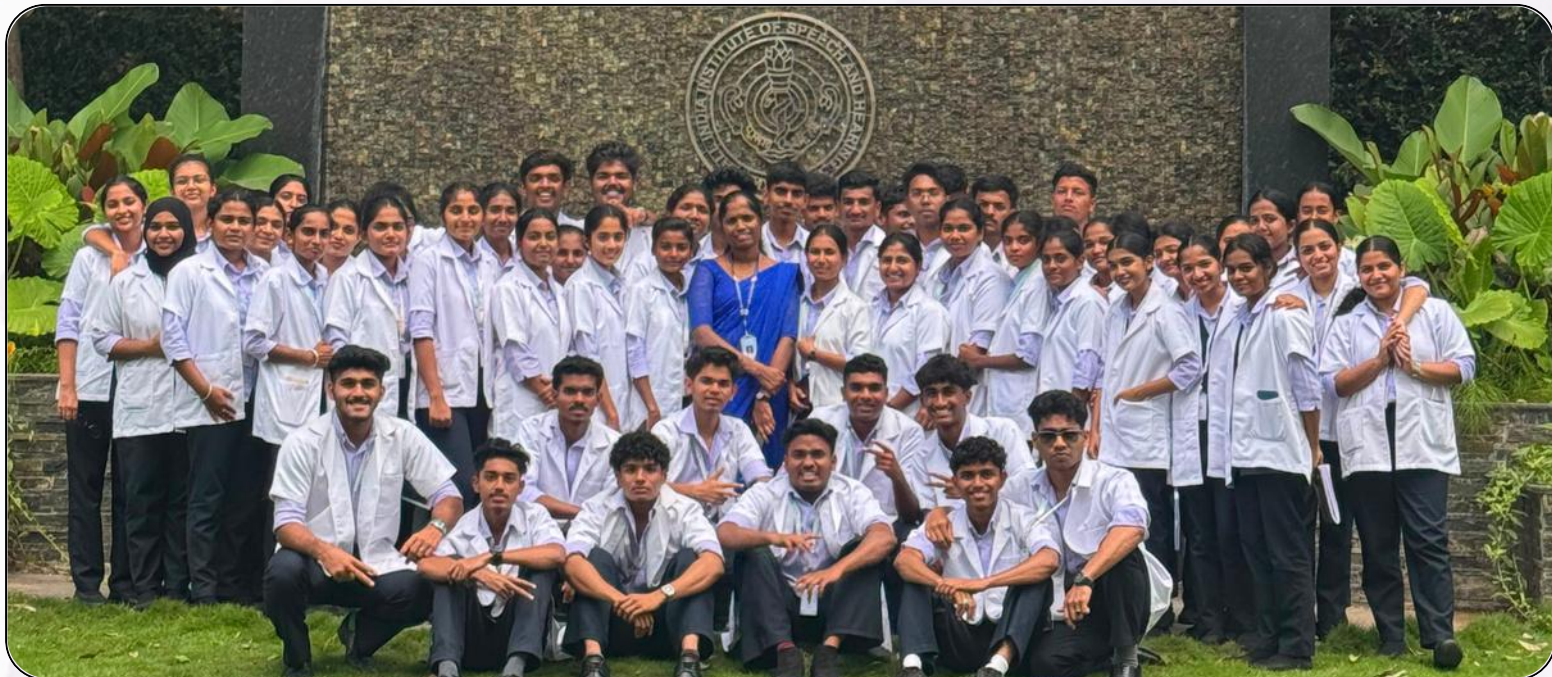

ADICHUNCHANAGIRI HOSPITAL AND RESEARCH CENTRE (AHRC)

AHRC - EVENTS

BGS BELAKU EYE CAMPS – JULY 2026

Under BGS Belaku, a total of 54 eye camps were successfully conducted across various PHCs/CHCs during July 2026, providing comprehensive eye-care services to the community. The camps recorded 536 outpatients and 398 inpatients, with 263 surgical procedures performed, including 250 cataract surgeries, 11 pterygium surgeries, and 2 DCT procedures. In addition, 135 cases of refractive errors were identified and managed, with 172 male and 226 female beneficiaries receiving eye-care services. All operated patients were advised to attend follow-up reviews at the OPD after 10 days and 3 weeks, while spectacles were provided to eligible beneficiaries at the respective camps.



MEGA HEALTH CHECK-UP AND BLOOD DONATION CAMP – JULY 2026

Adichunchanagiri Hospital and Research Centre conducted a Mega Health Check-up and Blood Donation Camp at Keragodu, Mandya District, on 27th July 2026. The camp provided healthcare services to 4,324 outpatients and 85 inpatients, comprising 46 males and 39 females. The blood donation drive successfully collected 18 units of blood, contributing to community healthcare and blood bank support.



GENERAL HEALTH CHECK-UP CAMP – JULY 2026

Adichunchanagiri Hospital and Research Centre conducted a General Health Check-up Camp at Bellur, Mandya District, on 28th July 2026. The camp provided healthcare services to 350 outpatients and 15 inpatients, including 11 males and 4 females, contributing to accessible and community-oriented healthcare services.



UJWALA – FREE EYE CHECK-UP AND SPECTACLE DISTRIBUTION PROGRAMME

As part of its community eye-care initiative, Adichunchanagiri Hospital conducted the UJWALA Free Eye Check-up and Spectacle Distribution Programme for school and college students. A total of 9,209 students were screened, with more than 1,005 students identified as requiring spectacles. The programme covered institutions including SBGNHS, BGSMPS, Abhyas School, Bright Shine School, Navodaya School, and other government schools in and around B.G. Nagara and Bellur Cross. Eligible students were provided or prescribed spectacles, promoting early detection of vision problems and improved eye health among young learners.



CENTRE FOR RESEARCH AND INNOVATION (CRI)

7TH MONTHLY RESEARCH REVIEW MEETING HELD AT ACU

The 7th Monthly Research Review Meeting of Adichunchanagiri University was held on 28th July 2026 at the IQAC Board Room, ACU, under the chairmanship of Dr. S. N. Sridhara, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and Dr. C. K. Subbaraya, Registrar. The meeting focused on reviewing the progress of research activities across the University and strengthening the institutional research ecosystem.

The meeting included a comprehensive review of faculty research publications, funded and non-funded research projects, and the progress of Ph.D. and PG scholars. Discussions were also held on Research Ethics, Intellectual Property Rights, regulatory compliance, and capacity building initiatives. The meeting emphasized promoting quality research, ethical practices, innovation, and continuous improvement in research performance across the University.
