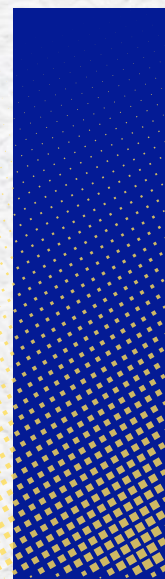
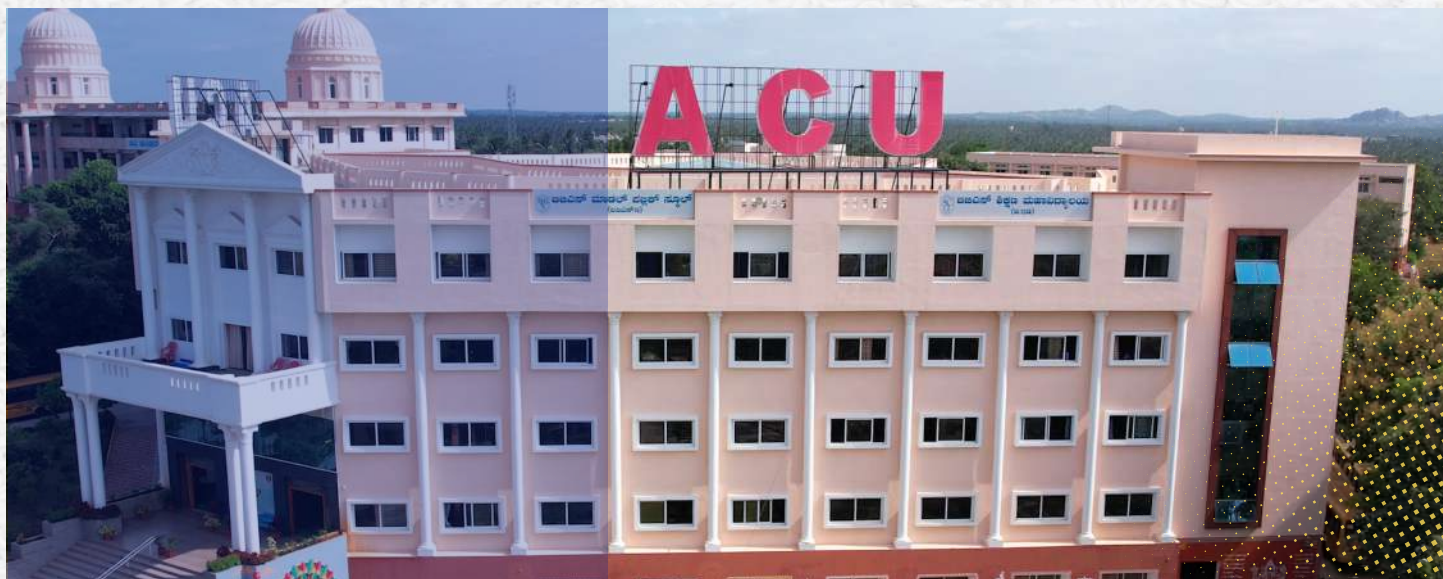

Micro-Teaching Skill Acquisition Programme to strengthen the professional teaching competencies of student teachers through structured training and guided practice.

Phase I: Skill Demonstration Phase was conducted from 02 February to 05 February 2026, during which faculty members demonstrated 11 essential micro-teaching skills, including lesson introduction, explanation, questioning, reinforcement, and effective use of the blackboard. These sessions helped student teachers clearly understand fundamental classroom teaching techniques.

Phase II: Skill Acquisition Phase was held from 05 March to 10 March 2026 under the coordination of Devaraju B. N., Assistant Professor. In this phase, student teachers practiced the demonstrated skills by preparing micro-lesson plans and delivering short teaching sessions in a simulated classroom setting. Feedback from faculty and peers enabled them to refine their teaching strategies and build confidence.

The programme provided an effective platform for experiential learning, helping aspiring teachers develop essential classroom skills and pedagogical competence.
